



Town Club ~ Salt Lake City, Utah

Founded in 1930, Town Club is a private social club for members and their invited guests, located at 1081 East South Temple Street in the historic Avenues neighborhood near downtown Salt Lake City.

The purpose of Town Club is to develop and foster charitable, civic, educational, recreational and social activities among the members.

History of Town Club

On April 28, 1930, Mrs. F. C. Schramm (Wynn Coman) invited eleven women to her home to organize a women's club in Salt Lake City, Utah. Mrs. Schramm was elected the first president of Town Club, and under her able leadership, it became a progressive and important organization.

Each April, the founding of Town Club is celebrated honoring the anniversary of Mrs. Schramm's birthday. Her portrait, painted by Lee Greene Richards, was commissioned by members of Town Club in 1945 and traditionally hangs over the fireplace in the Middle Lounge.

Town Club's first home was the former Sherman-Jackling home at 731 East South Temple Street. That building, constructed in 1898, was leased by Town Club until 1939 when the Club purchased the home of the Charles C. Bintz family at 1081 East South Temple Street. The Bintz home was built in 1909 by Mrs. Frances Walker, widow of Samuel Walker, eldest son of the Walker Brothers. In 1972, the home was placed on the Utah Historical Register. In 2020, Town Club celebrated its 90th Anniversary.

Hours of Operation

Town Club is open for Members' use Tuesday through Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. House closing time for events is 11:00 p.m.

Meal Service

The Dining Room has set times and menus. Regular lunch is Tuesday through Friday, Noon—1:30 p.m. Thursday evening dinner is 6:30—8:00 p.m. Reservations are required. Members may request special dietary needs menu at the time of reservation.

Attire

Appropriate 'business casual' attire is acceptable for men and women. Denim, t-shirts, sweatshirts and athletic wear are not acceptable. Special events may be exempt from these rules and specify other attire.

Parking

Town Club has a private lot in the rear of the building which includes designated spaces for persons with disabilities. There is ample street parking on the Avenues around Town Club.
